Historical note

Now a modern planned community built on the village model, Litchfield Park began as an agricultural company town built in 1916 by the Southwest Cotton Company in the desert west of Phoenix, Arizona. A subsidiary of Goodyear Tire and Rubber, Southwest Cotton Company was renamed Goodyear Farms in 1943. The town served as company headquarters for more than six decades. Between 1916 and 1952, Litchfield Park was home to Goodyear Farms executives and workers. In 1966, a development plan was commissioned from Victor Gruen Associates of California, marking the shift from an agricultural company town to a master-planned community as Litchfield Park actively sought to attract residents from outside the Goodyear family. Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company remained associated with the town until 1986, when SunCor Development Company of Phoenix acquired all Goodyear Farms interests.

Scope and content note

This collection consists primarily of records generated by Goodyear Farms, its predecessor Southwest Cotton Company, and other companies associated with the Goodyear operation. Although materials in the collection span the period 1900-1990s, the bulk of the holding covers 1917-1987, which is the entire period of the Goodyear presence in Arizona.

The material, which addresses the founding and subsequent development of the town of Litchfield Park and business operations of the companies, is arranged in nine subgroups: (1) Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company; (2) Goodyear Farms/Southwest Cotton Company; (3) Litchfield Park Association; (4) Litchfield Park Land and Development Company; (5) Litchfield Park Properties; (6) Litchfield Park Service Company; (7) SunCor Development Company; (8) Miscellaneous companies; and (9) Oversize materials. Common series within these subgroups include Correspondence, Legal records, Financial records, Ledgers, Reports, and Property files. The collection, consisting of approximately 220 linear feet of materials, is contained within 288 boxes of varying sizes. Ninety-seven ledgers are also included in the collection.

The largest subgroup, (2) Goodyear Farms/Southwest Cotton Company, contains several significant series. These include Engineering/planning (Series 3) which documents the townsite and its structures as well as field books, survey notes, and reports that document the planning and establishment of the town under the direction of Goodyear Tire and Rubber executive Paul W. Litchfield. The latter's administrative correspondence is contained in the Letterbook series (Series 2), which includes other important documentation about early operations in the community. The Publications/publicity series (Series 6) houses annual reports from the 1920s through the 1960s and is an excellent source for summary information about the community and the business operations. Series 6 also contains early townsite photographs and images of cotton farming operations during the period 1920s-1950s. Photographs of company executives and other employees are available in the Personnel series (Series 5).

The eighth subgroup, Miscellaneous companies, includes two particularly noteworthy series. Series 1, Agua Fria Land and Canal Company, includes a 1913 survey report of the area west of Phoenix which was undertaken to determine its suitability for agriculture. Series 8, Wigwam, contains various financial records and photo negatives of activities at the famous resort during the 1940s. The final subgroup, Oversize materials, includes drawings and maps documenting the ranches and structures of Southwest Cotton Company and Goodyear Farms, development of the Litchfield Park Townsite, and miscellaneous oversize items.
